ITC Global To Acquire The Assets of Broadpoint's Satellite Division, Broadening Global Managed Satellite Communications Services Capabilities - Broadpoint Will Retain Its Core Gulf Of Mexico Cellular Operations

St. Petersburg, Fl., and Perth, Western Australia, April 21, 2011 - ITC Global, an international provider of satellite communications services to the mining, energy and maritime industries, today announced it has entered into a definitive agreement to acquire the satellite operations of Broadpoint LLC, an established provider of communications services to the oil and gas sector in the Gulf of Mexico. Broadpoint will retain its core cellular telecommunications business, which operates the only ubiquitous cellular voice and data network in the Gulf of Mexico.
